

Ukraine

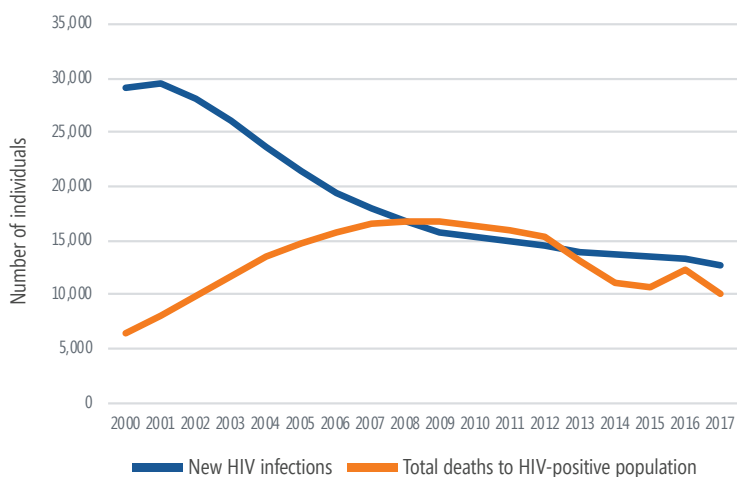
The U.S. government, through the President's Emergency Plan for AIDS Relief (PEPFAR), is partnering with the people and the Government of Ukraine to accelerate progress toward achieving HIV/AIDS epidemic control, with a focus on the following priorities:

- Continuing support for and technical assistance to the Government of Ukraine in implementation of health finance reform laws, particularly as they apply to HIV/AIDS, including comprehensive HIV guidelines
- Rapidly expanding lifesaving antiretroviral therapy (ART) through support to the National Center for Public Health for scale-up of treatment to 40,000 new patients through decentralization, differentiated services, multi-month scripting, regimen optimization, and Test and Start
- Ensuring rapid uptake of ART through rapid scale-up of effective HIV testing modalities, especially among key

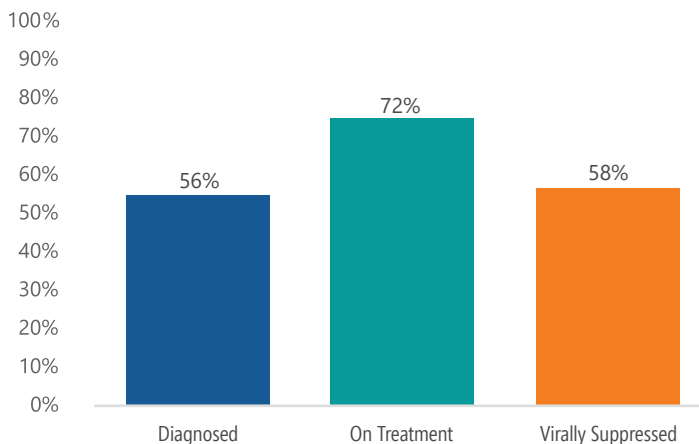
population groups, including index partner testing for all HIV-positive clients and expansion and optimization of provider-initiated counseling and testing; and promoting demand creation among key populations

- Improving linkage and retention through targeted key population operational research and refining case management models
- Ensuring high viral load suppression through improved retention and adherence activities
