

- Young men ages 20-34

- Strengthen leadership and capacity of civil society organizations and grassroots, community-based organizations to support the expansion of evidence-based services for AGYW
- Keep girls in secondary school
- Provide post-secondary school bridge to employment, including accessible and market driven vocational training
