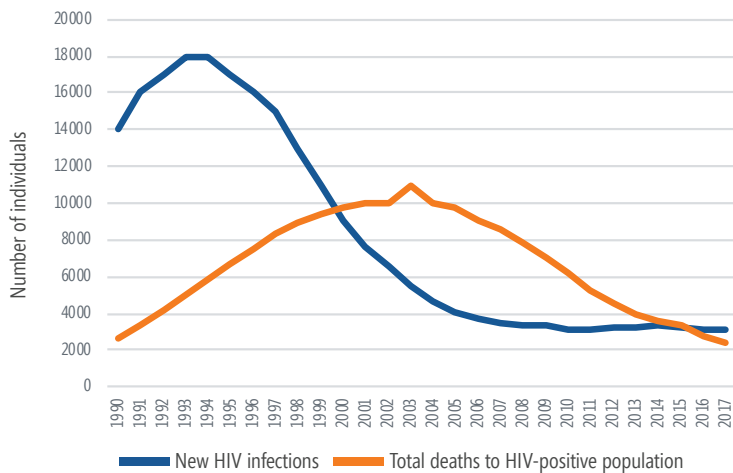


Burundi

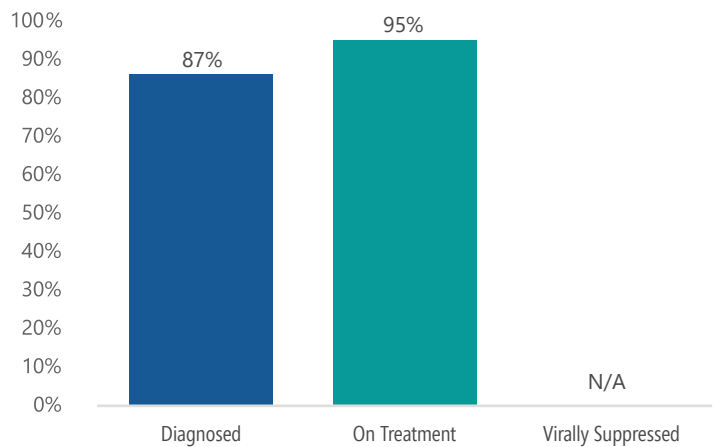
The U.S. government, through the President's Emergency Plan for AIDS Relief (PEPFAR), is partnering with the people and the Government of Burundi to accelerate progress toward achieving and maintaining HIV/AIDS epidemic control, with a focus on the following priorities:

- Intensify case-finding by focusing on high-yield testing strategies to identify HIV positives, namely index patient testing, HIV self-testing, and testing in high-yield entry points to services
- Working closely with the national network of people living with HIV to reach, test, and link underserved youth ages 15-24 and men
- Strengthening pediatric case finding and linkage to treatment
- Introducing pre-exposure prophylaxis for at high risk individuals
- Scaling same-day antiretroviral treatment initiation and differentiated models of care nationally including viral load testing
- Ensuring all populations at high-risk have access to HIV prevention and treatment services
